February 26–February 29, 2020



Seeking God's FACE: The next few days we will pray especially for the Christian people of our community to know God better and to live like Jesus. God wants to be closer than ever with His people. He's inviting us to come closer to Him, as if we were coming to talk with Him face to face.

WEDNESDAY

February 26

Bring us near to God.

Read: Matthew 17:1, 5

Pray: Lord, You took Your friends with You up the hill to meet with God. We are only brave enough to go into God's presence because of You and what You did for us on the cross. We are amazed with how happy and pleased our Father God is with You. With You standing beside us as our friend, God's love for us seems so BIG.

Today we pray:

- for others to come near to God and know His love.
- that we would want to be good just because we love Jesus.

THURSDAY

February 27

Teach us to be brave.

Read: Matthew 17:6-7

Pray: Jesus, how funny it seems to us that when amazing things happened the disciples would fall down. You were so kind to understand why they were afraid and to comfort them. Help us to be fearless and brave when You do things that we don't understand.

Today we pray:

- for amazing things from God to happen in our lives and in our families and friends.
- for the people in our city to know the comfort of the Lord when they are afraid.

FRIDAY

February 28

Live in the center of our hearts.

Read: Matthew 17:8

Pray: Jesus, our hearts and minds are often so easily filled up by the things we see and the things we want. We get side-tracked so easily when really we desire to see You. Would You come and grab our attention for the things You want to show us and teach us?

Today we pray:

- for the hearts of our family to be filled with God's ways.
- that people in our community will know Jesus and not just some ideas about Him.

February 29


Clean us up.

March 2

Give us ears to hear Your voice.

Read: Luke 10:41-42

Today we pray:

Read: Matthew 18:4

Today we pray:

- for our family to be humble and have clean hearts every day.

Today we pray:

March 7


Show Yourself to us.

Today we pray:

14 TUESDAY March 10

Shine Your light on us.

Read: John 12:35

Pray: Jesus, many people in our city live in darkness because they don't know You. They need to know the happy light of the truth about how much You love them. Show people who You really are—and bring them into Your light.

Today we pray:

- for the people in our city to be rescued from darkness.
- for our family to be a light in our community.

WEEK TWO:

Seeking God to spread the GOSPEL of Christ's kingdom: This week we will pray for the good news of Jesus to spread to every part of our city. Jesus helped people understand how much God loved them. We will pray that many will hear God's call to become followers of Jesus.

15 WEDNESDAY
March 11

Heal people to show Your love and power.

Read: Matthew 4:23

Pray: Jesus, You showed everyone what kind of world You wanted ours to be when You walked around telling people the good news and healing them. What a great way to show people how much You love them—by making them well when they are sick. When we see Your amazing care and power it makes us want to know You more.

Today we pray:

- that God will help people understand His love by healing them.
- that our family will be brave and pray for sick people like Jesus did.

16 THURSDAY
March 12

Send us.

Read: Luke 10:1-3

Pray: Jesus, You often sent Your friends into new cities before You. Maybe they did feel like lambs in the midst of hungry wolves sometimes—but they trusted that You were also coming soon. Send us into the parts of our city that need You the most. We trust You to go with us.

Today we pray:

- for Christians to spread Your Word to every neighborhood.
- that our family will be willing to go wherever You send us.

17 FRIDAY
March 13

We joyfully greet You.

Read: Mark 9:15

Pray: Lord, it is right for crowds to be amazed when they see You for who You really are. If people in our city could see how great You are they would come running to greet You. Open their eyes and hearts to truly understand how wonderful and good You are.

Today we pray:

- for families and friends and classmates and co-workers to run towards God.
- that churches all over our town will be ready to care for all the people who are coming to Jesus.

March 14


Glorify Your name.

21 TUESDAY March 17

Make us humble.

Read: Matthew 19:25-26

Pray: Jesus, we sometimes become proud of things we have accomplished, or how smart we are or how well we can do things. But we can't do anything without You. You are the One who gives us all of our abilities, all of our talents and who makes anything that we do possible. You are the Maker of all things and the Giver of all good gifts.

Today we pray:

- for Jesus to call the wise, the wealthy, the religious and the powerful in our community to Himself.
- for our family to remember Who has made us and given us all we have.

Read: Luke 13:16-17

Pray: Lord, many people today are captured by things that they don't understand. They believe things that are not true about themselves and others. They even say and do things they know are wrong and they do not know how to stop. Come, Jesus, and set people free and we will rejoice.

Today we pray:

- that those in our neighborhood who are mixed up in sad, bad things will be set free.
- that Jesus would receive the glory as He helps people live in freedom from evil.

FRIDAY

March 20

Help us to pray and not give up!

Read: Luke 18:1

Pray: Jesus, You told this story of a very faithful woman in the Bible. She kept asking for justice over and over again for a very long time until she finally got it. We want to follow her example and keep praying that You would make things good and right in our community. Give us strength and courage to keep asking, Lord.

Today we pray:

March 21


Defeat Your enemies.

Show us how to forgive.


Read: John 20:19-23

Read: Matthew 5:9

Pray: Lord, we don't live in a very peaceful world. There are plenty of troubles in faraway countries, in our town and everywhere in between. People want what somebody else has, or they don't like each other's skin color or they just want to be the boss of everything. Every place we know of could use a peacemaker. Show us how to be Your peacemakers.

Today we pray:

- for our family to be used as peacemakers in our community.
- for Jesus to speak peace into the struggling marriages and families in our neighborhood.

32 **SATURDAY**
March 28

Fill us with Your peace.

Read: Luke 19:41-42

Pray: Jesus, ours is a big city too, like this one in scripture that made You cry because of how hard-hearted the people were. 35 TUESDAY March 31

Show Your power.

Read: Luke 18:41-43

Pray: Jesus, help us to pray the kinds of prayers that make You famous. When people see the power that You have as You heal people and change lives, they can't wait to praise You. Do great things and become more famous in our town.

Today we pray:

- for Jesus to come when people cry out and tell Him what they need.
- for lots of praise to come from our city as people see the things Jesus does.

WEEK FIVE:
March 29–April 4, 2020



Seeking God to bring the JOY of Christ's kingdom: This week we will pray for God to bring the special happiness of hope in people's hearts. As people watch Jesus change the lives of their friends, God can make them glad deep inside as they look forward to the good surprises Jesus will bring.

36 WEDNESDAY
April 1

Bring life to the lifeless.

Read: Luke 7:13-16

Pray: Lord, look at our town and see all of the sad, hurting and lonely people. Many walk around as if their whole lives were a funeral march and they are always unhappy. This is not Your plan for people! Come and bring life and hope where there have only been gloomy hearts.

Today we pray:

- for Jesus to bring the light of His Spirit to those whose hearts are broken.
- for peace instead of confusion in the minds of people.

37 THURSDAY
April 2

Be our provider.

Read: Luke 12:32

Pray: Jesus, You know we sometimes act like sheep. We are frightened easily, we can't figure out where to go to find the best food and we sure can't find our way home by ourselves. We need You to protect us and guide us in the way we should go. You are our Good Shepherd and You promise that You will care for us.

Today we pray:

- that lost people in our community would realize how much they need a Shepherd.
- for the followers of Jesus to be free from fears and know that they are cared for.

38 FRIDAY
April 3

Thank You for all You have done.

Read: Luke 19:37

Pray: Lord, let there be amazing worship of You in places where there are a lot of people watching. Let people be surprised and full of joy at the knowledge of all the wonderful things You have done. Stir up our hearts so that we will be among the loudest ones praising You.

Today we pray:

- that all over our city, even in parks and in buildings, the Lord will be adored.
- for people to remember all the great things God has done and then want to glorify Him.

39 SATURDAY
April 4

Show Yourself to us!

Read: Luke 24:36

Pray: Jesus, when You arrived in a room everyone noticed! People wanted to be with You, listen to You, talk to You. Today, we know that our city can be changed by Your presence. Come and make Yourself known to us.

Today we pray:

- for others to see Jesus lived out in the everyday life of our family.
- for those who don't know Jesus to become aware of His loving presence.
